Veterans' Home Care

Veterans' Home Care is part of an Australian Government Department of Veterans' Affairs program to make sure that veterans and war widows or widowers maintain health, wellbeing and independence. It gives veterans and war widows or widowers practical help so they can continue living at home.

What support may be offered?

- / Domestic assistance, including cleaning, laundry and meal preparation
- / Safety related home and garden maintenance
- / Showering and dressing
- / Shopping
- / Respite care

How will Veterans' Home Care help me?

Services are delivered by skilled staff and are designed in partnership with you and your family. Our coordinator will work out a plan with you to help you receive services to assist you to remain independent at home while you access support and care.

Am I eligible to use the services?

You need to be assessed and referred to us from the Department of Veterans' Affairs (see contact details below), and you must have a White or Gold Repatriation Health Care Card to be able to access services.

Veterans' Home Care is available in metropolitan Adelaide and regional South Australia.

What does it cost?
