This fully accredited facility offers accommodation for up to 96 people and the majority of rooms overlook the gardens.

All rooms are comfortably furnished with electric beds, built-in wardrobes, lockable storage, fabric curtains and carpet. In addition, each room is fitted out with wide doors, a nurse call point and an individually controlled air conditioning system.

Everyone is encouraged to personalise their rooms

with furniture or belongings that are special to them. If you choose, you can also have a telephone, personal computer or bar fridge installed in your room.

Residents at Ingle Farm can get involved in a range of activities such as carpet bowls, bingo, craft group, exercise therapy, men's group activities, as well as attend regular concerts with visiting entertainers.

Physiotherapy, podiatry, exercise physiology and occupational therapy are offered on site. The home has recently completed a \$10m major redevelopment.

Residential Accommodation Prices

The amount you pay towards accommodation depends on your eligibility for government assistance. The Department of Human Services will determine whether a contribution towards or full payment for your room is applicable, which is dependent on your assessed income and assets.

There are options available as to how you pay for accommodation. Below is an example of paying accommodation in full in the form of a Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD) or as a Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP), and the option of a combination of a RAD and DAP. Other combination payment options can be negotiated, please speak to our Admissions team to discuss this further.
