The amount you pay towards accommodation depends on your eligibility for government assistance. Services Australia or DVA will determine whether a contribution towards, or full payment for, your room is applicable, which is dependent on your assessed income and assets.

There are options available as to how you pay for accommodation. Below is an example of paying accommodation in full in the form of a Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD) or as a Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP), and the option of a combination of a RAD and DAP. Other combination payment options can be negotiated, please speak to our Admissions team to discuss this further.
