Lealholme, Port Pirie

Lealholme is nestled between two nature reserves – Frank Green Park and Woodward Park – as well as being close to central Port Pirie.

Family and community are central to the day-to-day experience of Lealholme. Residents stay connected with regular events such as movie nights, concerts and bus excursions arranged by a dedicated Lifestyles Coordinator.

This fully accredited facility offers accommodation for up to 104 people and the majority of rooms overlook the gardens.

All rooms are comfortably furnished with electric beds, built-in wardrobes, lockable storage, fabric curtains and carpet. In addition, each room is fitted

out with wide doors, a nurse call point and an individually controlled air conditioning system.

Everyone is encouraged to personalise their rooms with furniture or belongings that are special to them. If you choose, you can also have a telephone, personal computer or bar fridge installed in your room.

Daily events include arts and crafts, snooker, indoor bowls, bingo and exercise therapy. Lealholme has established relationships with local kindergartens and residents enjoy inter-generational activities.

In 2016, the facilities were upgraded to include a specialised, built for purpose, Memory Support Unit.



Residential Accommodation Prices

The amount you pay towards accommodation depends on your eligibility for government assistance. Services Australia or DVA will determine whether a contribution towards, or full payment for, your room is applicable, which is dependent on your assessed income and assets.

There are options available as to how you pay for accommodation. Below is an example of paying accommodation in full in the form of a Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD) or as a Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP), and the option of a combination of a RAD and DAP. Other combination payment options can be negotiated, please speak to our Admissions team to discuss this further.
