Services Australia or DVA will determine the amount you pay, which is dependent on your assessed income and assets. Other fees may also be applied, such as the basic daily fee, a means tested care fee, and an additional services fee.

If you are assessed as being required to pay for accommodation, there are different payment options. Below is an example of paying in full in the form of a Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD) or a Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP), and the option of a combination RAD and DAP. Other combination options can be negotiated.
