What a difference two weeks can make! Stage Three is now nearing completion as we focus on the final details and is on track to reopen in March.

Thank you for your patience with the various shutdowns of the central lift over the past couple of weeks, we don't anticipate any further shutdowns for the remainder of Stage Three.

On Monday 16 February there will be a brief scheduled shutdown of water to the western side of the building, affecting all levels. This is scheduled to take place at 5am to minimise disruption and anticipated to be back on by 7am. Please see the list of rooms affected below:
