Dear residents, families and representatives,

This week we received all of the furniture and furnishings to begin fitting out Stage Three, thank you for your patience with the lift shutdown earlier this week so that we could ensure the safe and efficient delivery of these items up to Level Three. We will spend the next couple of weeks completing these new spaces in preparation for residents moving into the new suites in mid March.

As we near the end of Stage Three, we are starting to prepare for the commencement of Stage Four. During the week commencing Tuesday 10 March we will be blocking off the lift next to Reception and this will remain unavailable for the duration of Stage Four, which is expected to conclude in late July. During this time the lift next to Grivell Hall will be the only lift available for Rotary House.

You may remember that the first few weeks of each stage is the noisiest part of the refurbishment as we remove the old flooring and grind it down in preparation for the new flooring. We anticipate that this will start in the week commencing Monday 16 March but we will provide more detail in the next update.

### **What happened this fortnight?**

- The wall where the external lift had entered the building was repaired, this space will become one of the new music rooms
- All electrical work was completed
- The final clean commenced
- All furniture and furnishings were delivered
