Dear residents, families and representatives,

Firstly, we sincerely thank you for your understanding this week with the noisy works taking place on Level Three.

The noise is due to jack hammers removing the concrete flooring in the old ensuites and the tiles from the outdoor balcony area, as well as the floor grinder removing the glue from the old floors in the suites and corridors in preparation for new flooring to be laid.

We are hopeful that these works will be completed by next Friday 3 April.

Please remember that during this time there are a number of options available to you if you would like to escape the noise:

- Noise-cancelling headphones and Bluetooth headphones are available upon request and can be connected to the TV when noise becomes loud. Please speak with the team on your floor, or the Lifestyle team, to arrange these.
- Residents in affected areas can request a complimentary coffee from the café while the noisy works are taking place, please speak with any member of the café team to enjoy a warm beverage on us.
- There are a number of quiet spaces for you to enjoy:
  - Lounge area between Angas and Gill: large-screen TV for your entertainment
  - Rotary House Level One north dining room lounge area: movies
  - Rotary House Level Two theatrette: movies
  - Grivell Hall: activities as per the lifestyle calendar

- New signage was installed on Level Two


